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- Prices based on a **3-day/2-night visit**. 5-day courses are also available—please enquire about fees
- 3-day courses run from around 9.30 on Monday/Wednesday to around 2.30 on Wednesday/Friday
- **Maximum group size** is 34 pupils plus 4 adults. Adult places are free at a ratio of 1 : 8
- Where group size is less than 20 there will be a **minimum charge** equivalent to the fee for 20 pupils (with the exception of Special Schools)
- **Bursaries of up to £30 per eligible child** available from the Stibbington Centre Greener Futures Trust. An application form for completion by Head teachers is available
- It may be possible for schools to allocate **pupil premium** funding to further subsidise the residential experience for pupils eligible for free school meals
- Schools may be able to offer to fund a **further reduction** to those pupils who are eligible for free school meals, equivalent to 3 times the cost of the lunches that will not be provided by their school
- Where a single booking spans two charging periods the lower rate will apply
- Some programmes may incur a small additional charge, for example where a minibus is required.
